Additional Information

Coaching

It is a requirement of this course that students conduct team coaching sessions in both Soccer and Gaelic outside of college hours

Work Experience

It is a requirement of this course that students complete two weeks work experience in a leisure centre.

ITEC diploma in Gym Instruction

A number of places are available to Sports Coaching and Leisure Management students to complete an **ITEC Diploma in Gym Instruction**, in addition to the FETAC Level 5 Award in Sports Coaching and Leisure Management.

Students wishing to complete this qualification should note the following:

- It is desirable that you have taken Biology at Leaving Certificate level
- As part of this qualification you will have to be able to take sessions in Step Aerobics, Circuit Training, Weight Training and Flexibility. There is a practical exam in this area.
- In addition to the course tracksuit, students must also purchase an exam polo shirt, uniform runners and a stopwatch.
